



Information clause for persons who have consented to the processing of their personal data for marketing purposes

1. **[Personal Data Administrator]** The companies of the ES-SYSTEM Group that are subject to an agreement on co-administration, hereinafter referred to as: the Co-Administrators, are the collective Administrator of your personal data. An excerpt from the above-mentioned agreement has been published on the Co-Administrators' websites, particularly www.essystem.pl and www.wilkasy.essystem.pl (in the "Personal data" tab). It is these entities that determine the purposes and means of processing your personal data.
2. **[Contact details]** The Co-Administrators have appointed the following point of contact for data subjects: the Data Protection Inspector, ES-SYSTEM S.A., address: ul. Przemysłowa 2, 30-701 Kraków, Poland, e-mail address: inspektorodo@essystem.pl.
3. **[Inspector]** The Co-Administrators have appointed a Data Protection Inspector for the purpose of ongoing monitoring of compliance with the principles of the proper protection of personal data. You can contact the Inspector by sending an email to the following address: inspektorodo@essystem.pl.
4. **[Purpose]** The Co-Administrators process your personal data solely on the basis of law and for specific purposes, i.e. for marketing purposes, particularly to promote services and goods offered by the Co-Administrators, especially in order to send offers, newsletters, information, advertising and promotional materials regarding goods or services, as well as for promotional and marketing events organized by the Co-Administrators and other events organized by them in relation to the scope of their activities, as well as events, which the Co-Administrators are participants in.
5. **[Recipients]** The recipients of the personal data provided by you are suppliers of goods and services necessary for the fulfillment of the above-mentioned purposes, entities affiliated with the Co-Administrators personally or through capital and the Co-Administrators' legal successors, as well as entities authorized by law, including state authorities.
6. **[Data storage period]** Your data will be stored until you withdraw consent.
7. **[Rights]** You are entitled to the right to access the content of your personal data and to correct it, the right to delete it or limit its processing, as well as the right to transfer the data. You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, and the withdrawal of consent can be performed through a unilateral declaration and does not affect the lawfulness of the processing that was performed on the basis of consent before its withdrawal. You are also entitled to the right to file a complaint to the supervisory authority – the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.
8. **[Automated decision making]** Personal data processed on the basis of this consent will be subject to automated processing, including profiling, however this processing will not lead to automated decision making causing legal consequences or significantly affecting you in any similar way, as referred to in art. 22 par. 1 of the GDPR. This means that your personal data will only be used to adapt our materials to suit you, so that you only receive information that is consistent with your interests.
9. Providing personal data is voluntary.
10. **[Legal basis]** The legal basis for the processing of personal data is contained in art. 6 par. 1 letter a of the GDPR.
